sold released confirmed and conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell re
lease confirm and convey unto them the said Abraham Lillijohn John L Richardson Daniel
Brown Solomon Leonard Henry Connely L B Burnet James Duillian and their successors &
trustees in trust for the use and purposes herein after mentioned and declared) all the estate
right title interest, property, claim and demand whatsoever either in Law or equity which he the
said Williams hath to or upon all and singular a lot or piece of land situate lying and being
in the County and state afore said, bounded and bounded as follows to wit Beginning on a Blackjack
running thence North thirty west 55 fifty five poles to a Spanish Oak thence eighteen poles East thirty west
to a post oak thence South thirty East fifty five poles to a pine thence to the beginning laid out
side acres of land to the same parcel left to gether with all and singular the houses woods waters ways
privileges and appertanances there unto belonging or in any wise pertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the above mentioned and described lot or piece of land situate lying and being
said, together with and singular the houses woods waters ways and privileges there to belonging or
in any wise appertaining unto them the said Trustees and their successors in office, for use in trust
that they shall erect ~~an~~ ~~house~~ ~~or~~ ~~cause~~ to be erected thereon a house or place of wor
ship for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal church in the United States of
America according to the rules and discipline which from time to time may be a given upon and
adopted by the ministers and preachers of the said Church at their general conferences in the United
States of America and in further trust and confidence that they shall at all times forever here
after permit such ministers and preachers belonging to the said ^{church} as shall from time to time be duly
authorised by the general conference of the ministers and preachers of the said Methodist Episcopal Church
or by the annual conferences authorized by the same, to preach and expound Gods holy word therein with
the ordinances of the Gospel of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ according to the discipline of
said Church and in further trust and confidence that as often a vacancy of trustees may occur by
death or otherwise the preacher in charge shall fill it as soon as may be as the discipline directs
so as to keep the number of nine for ever, And in further trust and confidence they shall conti
nue the Northern end where the dead is now deposited in the same size giving it such extension as the
boundaries of the above lot and exigencies may admit or require. And the said ^{lot} ~~lot~~ by these
